

Resource type: external**IPA - Project Initiation Routemap requirements module**

The *Project Initiation Routemap* is an aid to strategic decision-making, developed by the Infrastructure Client Group as part of the Infrastructure and Projects Authority. The Routemap provides further diagnostics on addressing common capability gaps that typically need to be enhanced, such as blurred governance structures, or lack of alignment between benefits and requirements. These areas are explored in more depth in a number of 'Align for Success modules'.

Of those, the first module is requirements, to ensure that:

- the strategic case for the project is strong;
- planning, scoping and delivery activities are aligned with the organisation's objectives.

This will provide a sound basis for the quantitative and qualitative measures by which the success of the project will be judged, and help counter over-optimism.
